1. Beethoven's Pastorale

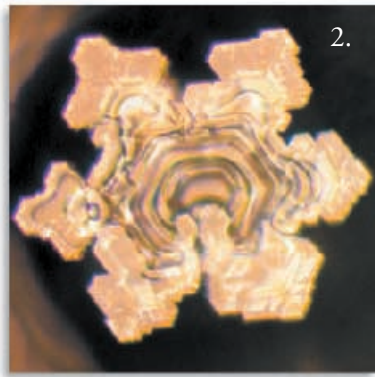
This is a bright, happy, joyous music. This beautiful crystal tells us that good music can positively affect water.



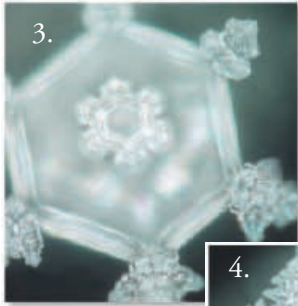
Research was done to find out. There were many factors to think about before playing music to water.

Here is what we tried: We placed a bottle of water between two speakers and played an entire song at normal volume. Then we tapped the bottom of the water bottle and left it overnight.

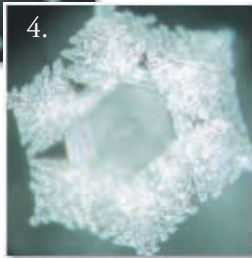




2. Mozart's Symphony No. 40 in G Minor
This music quietly heals the hearts of its listeners.



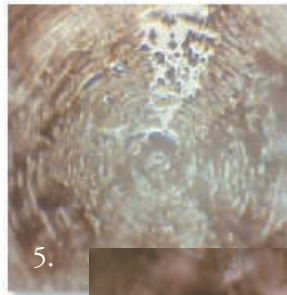
3. Vivaldi's The Four Seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter

It stores the energy until the coming of another spring.

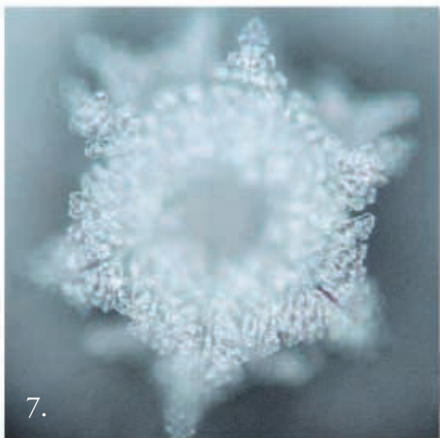
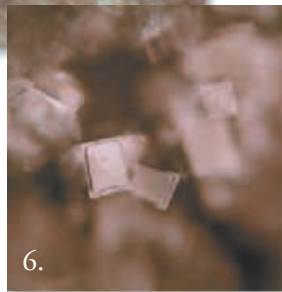
5. Heavy metal music

6. Popular Japanese music

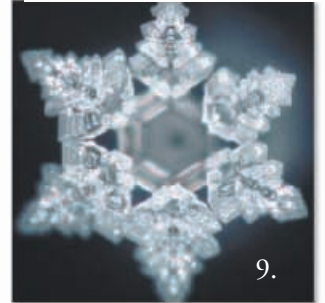
This is a popular song for young people. However it only made four-sided crystals. Seems like popular song does not necessarily create good crystals.

This created a broken crystal. It represents the fact that wars will not create anything.

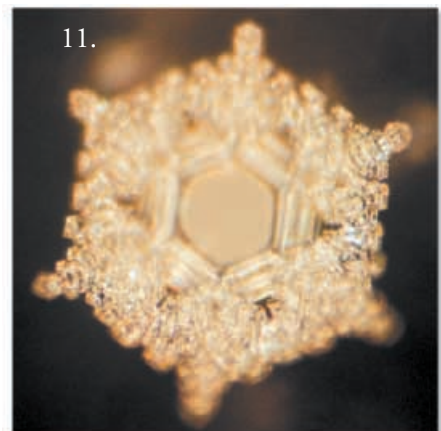


9. Hope
